#### **REPLYING AFFIDAVIT**

I JUSTUS NYANG'AYA, an adult mind of sound mind and disposition residing in Nairobi within the Republic of Kenya and C/o Rachier & Amollo LLP, Mayfair Center, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor, Ralph Bunche Rd, P.O Box 55645-00200, do hereby make oath and state as follows:

- 1. **THAT** I am a commissioner of the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent and the 6<sup>th</sup> Respondent herein and I am conversant with the facts in issue and hence competent to swear this affidavit in response to the issues raised in the Presidential Election petitions filed against the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent and ourselves herein.
- 2. **THAT** I am aware that there are other petitions filed against the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent and myself in my individual capacity and I swear this affidavit in response to all such petitions.
- 3. **THAT** the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent is an independent commission established under Article 88 of the Constitution as read together with the Independent Electoral and Boundaries Commission Act (Hereinafter 'The IEBC Act').
- 4. **THAT** Section 5 of the IEBC Act provides that the commission shall consist of the Chairperson and 6 other commissioners appointed in accordance with Article 250(4) of the Constitution and as such, any mention of the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent simultaneously refers to the 7 commissioners.

- 5. **THAT** from the foregoing, it is my understanding that even when a function is charged to an employee of the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent, then the said employee would simply be discharging some delegated authority and must thus operate within the limits of the Constitution and National Legislation.
- 6. **THAT** a reading of the Constitution together with the Elections Act and the IEBC Act reveals that the functions of the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent include the following;
  - a) Conducting or supervising referenda and elections to any elective body or office established by this Constitution, and any other elections as prescribed by an Act of Parliament. (Article 88(4) of the Constitution).
  - b) Facilitating the observation, monitoring and evaluation of the election (Article 88(4)(h) of the Constitution).
  - c) Counting the votes, tallying, verifying the count and thereafter declaring the result (Article 138(3(c) of the Constitution)
  - d) Determining, declaring and publishing the results of an election immediately after close of polling (Section 39 of the Elections Act, 2011).
  - e) Appointing constituency returning officers to be responsible for tallying, collating, announcement and declaration of results from the polling stations at a constituency (Section 39(1A) of the Elections Act, 2011)
  - f) Tallying and verifying the results received at the constituency tallying Centre and the national tallying Centre for the purposes of the Presidential Election (Section 39(1)(C)(b) of the Elections Act, 2011)
  - g) Publishing the polling result forms on an online public portal maintained by the Commission (Section 39(1(C)(c) of the Elections Act, 2011).
  - h) Verifying that the results transmitted are an accurate record of the results tallied, verified and declared at the respective polling stations (Section 39(1D) of the Elections Act).
  - i) Establishing a mechanism for the live-streaming of results as announced at polling stations to facilitate public information (Section 39(1G) of the Elections Act, 2011)
  - j) Announcing the final results in the order in which the tallying of the results is completed (Section 39(3) of the Elections Act)
  - k) Formulating the policy and strategy of the Commission
- 7. **THAT** from the foregoing, it follows logically that any responsibility that is vested on the "Commission" whether under the Constitution, the IEBC Act or the IEBC regulations is actually vested upon ALL the commissioners of IEBC except in situations where reference is made explicitly to Chairman of IEBC.
- 8. **THAT** Article 138(3)(c) of the Constitution for example vests upon the Commission the responsibility to "tally, "verify" and "declare" results of all elections including presidential elections.

- 9. THAT if it follows logically therefore that the responsibility to "tally", "verify" and "declare" results of ALL elections is primarily vested on ALL the SEVEN (7) Commissioners including myself.
- 10. **THAT** the fact that the commission may delegate such functions to officers of the commission in certain instances does not eliminate the primary responsibility which remains at all times with the commissioners.
- 11. **THAT** the only responsibility that is vested **SOLELY** on the Chairman of the commission is the responsibility to declare the results pursuant to the provisions of Article 138(10)(a) of the Constitution as read together with section 39(1)(G) of the Elections Act 2011. However, the fact that Article 138(3)(c) vests the primary responsibility to declare results on the "Commission" mean that the chairman can only declare (under Article 138(10)(a) results that have already been declared (i.e. determined to be correct) by the commission.
- 12. **THAT** it is therefore inconceivable that the Chairman of the Commission can proceed to declare results that have not even been verified and confirmed to be correct by the Commission.
- 13. **THAT** the constitution at Article 81(e) also defines the irreducible standards that must be met by the commission in its endeavor to deliver a free and fair election. They include:
  - (a) Secrecy of the ballot
  - (b) Freedom from violence, intimidation, improper influence and corruption.
  - (c) Transparency
  - (d) Neutrality, impartiality, efficiency, accuracy and accountability.
- 14. **THAT** the Commission (through the commissioners) is therefore enjoined by law to ensure not only that every election is administered in an impartial, efficient, accurate and accountable manner but more importantly to ensure that the Kenyan public and indeed the whole world is enabled to see and judge for themselves that the election was so administered.
- 15. **THAT** according to section 8 of the IEBC Act as read together with the provisions of paragraph 5 and 7 of the second schedule tot eh said Act the mandate of the commission can only be lawfully discharged by "the majority" of the existing commissioners.

- 16. **THAT** the commission presently has **SEVEN** (7) Commissioners. It follows logically therefore that the Commission cannot lawfully act except through the decisions taken by at least **FOUR** (4) Commissioners.
- 17. **THAT** section 26 of the IEBC Act entrenches the principle of public participation and consultation. It follows therefore that the Commission must ensure that the principles of Public Participation and Consultation are always adhered to all the time. It follows logically that no decision can be taken by the Chairman of the Commission, on behalf of or in the name of the Commission without consulting all the Commissioners.
- 18. THAT on 9th August 2022 the Commission conducted a presidential election.
- 19. THAT the voting process went on smoothly save for some hitches with the KIEMS kit and a mix up of ballot papers causing the postponement of some of the elections in certain areas of the country.
- 20. **THAT** once the voting was done, the tallying process began at the polling centres, resulting in the transmission of form 34As in digital format to both the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent's portal and the Public portal.
- 21. **THAT** on the 15<sup>th</sup> of August 2022, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent announced the outcome of the presidential election, an occurrence that was preceded by activities that would later inform the filing of election petitions against the said announcement.
- 22. **THAT FOUR (4)** members of the Commission including myself, having been sidelined and ambushed by the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent in the days and the hours leading up to the announcement of the results, left the National Tallying center after the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent had walked out on the commissioners during the meeting of the Commission that preceded the announcement of the Presidential winner.
- 23. **THAT** my leaving of the national tallying center before the announcement by the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent was informed by my inability to vouch for and confirm the accuracy, transparency and verifiability of the results that were just about to be announced by the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent for reasons outlined herein.
- 24. **THAT NINE (9)** separate petitions have now been lodged challenging the outcome of the said presidential elections and I have been named in **FIVE (5)** of them as a Respondent.
- 25. **THAT** in the said petitions, the petitioners *inter alia* challenged the accuracy of the declared result owing to a perceived lack of transparency in the manner in which the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent had conducted itself and the fact that the verifiability of the results could not be established.

- 26. **THAT** having been a part of the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent during the conduct of the said election my substantive response to the issues raised in the petitions is as follows;
- 27. **THAT** with regards to the claims of lack of transparency, I am aware that Article 81(e)(4) of the Constitution provides that free and fair elections contemplated under the said Article shall be transparent.
- 28. THAT the supreme court has previously established the elements of a transparent election in Presidential Election 1 of 2017, Raila Amollo Odinga & another v Independent Electoral and Boundaries Commission & 2 others [2017] eKLR where the court at Paragraph 282 stated as follows;
  - .....(e) a transparent election whose polling, counting and tallying processes as well as the announcement of results are open to observation by and copies of election documents easily accessible to the polling agents, election observers, stakeholders and the public and, as required by law, a prompt publication of the polling results forms is made on the public portal.
- 29. **THAT** since the Constitution expect that every process and activity undertaken by the commission is communicated and demonstrated to the public and all stakeholders in real time, the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent put in place all measures to ensure the same happened and to that end, it is therefore not true that the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent, in its role as the body mandated to conduct and supervise elections neglected its role in ensuring adequate measures had been put in place to ensure transparency of the electoral process.
- 30. **THAT** as part of the preparations for the said election the commission had appointed me as the person in charge of all Information and Communication (ICT) affairs of the commission.
- 31. **THAT** it follows logically that I am the one who should have been directly involved in all discussions, negotiations and meeting with all third parties who would provide ICT services to the commission on the election day.
- 32. **THAT** on the election day the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent unilaterally transferred all ICT related functions to staff of the commission and instructed that I should only handle protocol issues.
- 33. **THAT** the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent had previously appointed himself as the Returning Officer for the presidential election without involving the other six commissioners including myself.
- 34. **THAT** I am aware that a foreigner by the name GUDINO OMOR was able to access the commission's server using user ID "O" and to pull down results that had been uploaded from the polling stations and to later upload fresh results.

- 35. THAT GUDINO OMOR was active on the server from 1<sup>st</sup> June 2022 and remained extremely active on the server till well after the election.
- 36. **THAT** since all the details of the logs are indicated it is very easy to establish what GUDINO OMOR was doing on the server each time he accessed the server.
- 37. **THAT** I do not understand what a foreigner would be doing on the commission's server during the election period nor do I understand why GUDINO OMOR was always busy on IEBC server at night.
- 38. **THAT** as far as I am aware the commission has never given access rights to the IEBC server to GUDINO OMOR.
- 39. **THAT** as far as I am aware the commission has never been formally given the details of the other Three Hundred and Seventy-Seven people who accessed the IEBC server during the election period.
- 40. **THAT** as far as am aware, the commission had developed any protocol or other guidelines that would indicate the circumstances (if any) when an already uploaded form 34A from the polling station would be pulled down and replaced subsequently.
- 41. **THAT** I am also aware that other commission staff by the names of ABDIDAHIR MAALIM, MOSES SUNKULI and GEDION BALANG were also able to access the commission's servers, to pull down some results uploaded thereat and subsequently upload other results. These are the same officers who were helping the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent to unilaterally process the results, that were subsequently declared by the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent. Annexed hereto and marked as JN-1 is a copy of the logs obtained from the IEBC server which indicate not only that GUDINO OMOR and the named IEBC staff were busy interfering with data stored on the server, but also indicating exactly what they did and when.
- 42. **THAT** all this information can be ascertained by this court upon scrutiny. Unless it is established what exactly was being done.
- 43. **THAT** I do not understand the circumstances in which it would have been necessary to pull down results already uploaded from the polling station and later re-upload the same.
- 44. **THAT** I am also aware that after the previously pulled down results were uploaded afresh there would be amendments to Form 34B.

- 45. **THAT** the three commission staff aforesaid were working directly with the Chairman of the commission throughout.
- 46. **THAT** from the foregoing, it is clear that whatever results had been processed unilaterally by the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent working together with the named commission staff could not be verified as correct until after it had been established exactly what the foreigner and the named IEBC staff were doing on the server.
- 47. THAT the petitions raise a number of fundamental issues around the tallying and verification including assertions that some of the forms were tampered with/altered to favour certain candidates at the expense of others and further, that the result declared was marred by inconsistencies in terms of the actual number of voters who cast their vote on the 9<sup>th</sup> of August and whether any of the candidates did actually attain the Constitutional threshold of 50% plus 1 vote.
- 48. THAT the Supreme Court in the aforesaid presidential Petition 1 of 2017 established the elements of what a verifiable election should look like by stating at paragraph 282 that; "Having therefore shown that the transmission of results was done in a manner inconsistent with the expectations of Section 39(1C) of the Elections Act, we must of necessity return to the principles in Articles 81 and 86 of the Constitution which we have already reproduced. Of importance are the expectations of transparency, accountability, simplicity, security, accuracy, efficiency and especially, verifiability of the electoral process. These terms should be understood to refer to:
  - (a) an accurate and competent conduct of elections where ballots are properly counted and tabulated to yield correct totals and mathematically precise results;
  - (b) an election with a proper and verifiable record made on the prescribed forms, executed by authorized election officials and published in the appropriate media;
- 49. **THAT** the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent put in place appropriate measures to conduct the process of tallying and verification on the knowledge that Article 138(3)(c) of the Constitution as read together with Section 39(1C) of the Elections Act, 2011 gave it the power to tally and verify the results.
- 50. **THAT** verification of the forms submitted at the National tallying center required the input of all the 7 Commissioners of the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent working in tandem with the party agents and employees of the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent.
- 51. **THAT** because of the sheer number of the forms 34A and forms 34B, it would be illogical to claim that the 7 commissioners would be able to on their own verify all such forms, bearing in mind the Constitutional timelines on declaration of the results.

- 52. **THAT** the foregoing notwithstanding, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent's actions during the tallying and verification at the National Tallying center made it difficult for me to ascertain the total number of votes cast and the actual votes attained by each candidate as to enable me authoritatively state that the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent had reached mathematically precise results for the following reasons;
  - a) While Section 39(1)(C)(b) of the Elections Act, 2011 mandates the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent as a whole to Tally and verify the results received at the constituency tallying Centre and the national tallying Centre for the purposes of the Presidential Election in line with Article 138(3)(c) of the Constitution, and while Section 39(1D) of the Elections Act, 2011 mandates the commission as a whole to Verify that the results transmitted are an accurate record of the results tallied, verified and declared at the respective polling stations the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent excluded myself and the other commissioners from the process and instead reduced us to the role of reading out to the public the results which to him had been tallied and verified and the totals written on the back of form 34B.
  - b) That the furthest I went with regards to verification was confirming that the total number of form 34As submitted matched the number of polling centers indicated on the form 34B, a far cry from actual verification of the quality of the entries in the said forms as to enable me vouch for the accuracy of the election.
  - c) I am aware that during the process of tallying and verification, party agents raised several issues with regards to apparent errors on the forms presented at the National Tallying center and that further, any such errors discovered from the comparisons of physical and digital forms were crystallized into error forms which were then submitted to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent. The said error forms were never shared with myself or the other commissioners, making it difficult for me to authoritatively say the said election was accurate and verifiable.
  - d) That on certain occasions once I had read the results out to the public as instructed by the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent, I got calls from some members of the public who asserted that the results I was reading were different from what they know was initially declared at the Constituency but there was no way for me to verify the same because the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent was clear in asserting himself as the Sole National returning officer in charge of Tallying and verification.
  - e) While the totals for each constituency as verified by the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent were fed into the portal back end for the generation of the consecutive totals and then generation of Form 34Cs, I was excluded from the process of feeding the information into the portal and generation of from 34Cs for only the chair had access to the portal backend that received the totals and as such, I am not in a position to verify that what was arrived at as the total during the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent's tallying and verification is what was actually fed into the portal to generate form 34C.
  - f) That I am in my personal capacity unable to authoritatively state whether/or not any of the candidates attained the Constitutional threshold of 50% plus 1 vote because the 2<sup>nd</sup>

Respondent failed to share with me the information from the KIEMS Kit with regards to the total votes cast and further, the total votes cast using the manual register. In fact myself and the other commissioners asked the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent for manual register totals but the said conversation elicited no response from the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent.

- g) To that end, at the point of announcement of the results on the 15<sup>th</sup> of August 2022, I did not have the verified totals of votes cast using both the digital and manual registers, neither did I have the verified totals of what each candidate got as to allow me to independently make a computation under Article 138(4) of the Constitution and establish whether any candidate achieved the threshold.
- h) At the time the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent informed the commissioners that he had decided to go declare the final result of the presidential election, 27 Constituencies had not been announced and as far as I am aware, Commissioner Guliye was set to announce the same. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent never informed me why he had decided to make a declaration before announcing all the constituencies.
- i) While I am aware that the Elections Act, 2011 allows the chair to declare the results before all constituencies are announced if in his opinion the remaining votes cannot alter the final tally, I had no information on the total votes cast for each candidate in the remaining 27 Constituencies as to independently establish that indeed, the gap between the eventual winner and the runners up was so substantial that the remaining constituencies would not affect the outcome.
- 53. **THAT** the petitions further asserted that there was possible interference in the election process by foreign nationals and in doing so, pointed to the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent's defence of the said foreign nationals.
- 54. **THAT** in response, I wish to clarify that the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent never tendered any defence of the said foreign nationals. Instead, whatever was purportedly said to the nation by the commission was the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent's position who merely used the name of the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent to pass his own message.
- 55. **THAT** it is my understanding that the act of availing information to the public during the election period amounts to a decision by the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent and by acting unilaterally in defence of the foreign nations, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent contravened the second schedule to the IEBC Act which requires that any decision to be made by the commission has to have the backing of the majority members. To that end, it is thus not true that the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent defended the foreign nationals who then allegedly proceeded to tamper with the election.
- 56. **THAT** the 1<sup>st</sup> Respondent never had any meeting where it was agreed upon by the majority as contemplated under Schedule 2 of the IEBC Act that there would be intentional tampering with the KIEMS kit so as to cause them to fail in the areas in which they did fail in order to

induce voter apathy and as such, it cannot be said that the 1st Respondent intentionally suppressed the voting in the subject areas.

- 57. **THAT** in response to the claim by some of the petitioners that by virtue of the perceived irregularities and illegalities with regards to the presidential election, then there was no General election on the 9<sup>th</sup> of August 2022, I state as follows;
  - a) That the said claim is not founded on any facts or law because the petitioners have not presented any facts to challenge the outcome of the other elections apart from the presidential one and in any case, the petition before this Court challenges and is by law required to challenge the presidential election outcome.
  - b) That in any case, the Supreme Court does not have original jurisdiction to determine questions relating to the election of Governors, Senators, Women representatives, Members of the national Assembly and Members of the County Assembly under Article 163(3) of the Constitution, neither does it have the jurisdiction to declare that the WHOLE election as conducted on August 9th 2022 was a sham.
- 58. **THAT** it is on this basis that the I swear this affidavit in response to the petitions filed to challenge the Presidential Election outcome as declared by the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent.

59. **THAT** the facts deposed to herein are within my knowledge and belief, sources whereof have been disclosed.
